- The 100 Kings program requires a commitment from both students enrolled in the program and their parent(s)/guardian(s). ☐
- The 100 Kings program is a year-round, multi-year program. Students enrolled in the program must participate during all three trimesters (summer, fall, and spring). ☐
- Students enrolled in the 100 Kings program can miss no more than two (2) days per trimester in order to meet program attendance requirements. Types of absences include, but not limited to, sickness, vacation, academic, and sports. ☐
- The 100 Kings program has a no-cell phone policy for students during sessions. ☐
- Students enrolled in the 100 Kings program are expected to meet Kings Etiquette, which outlines behavior expectations, dress code, session participation, and other program requirements. ☐
- Parents/Guardians of students in the 100 Kings program must ensure their student(s) arrive 15 minutes before session start time, are prepared with session materials, and picked up promptly at the conclusion of session. ☐
- Parents/Guardians of students in the 100 Kings program are expected to volunteer minimally three (3) hours per year. ☐
- Parents/Guardians of students in the 100 Kings program must check emails regularly, as it is the primary method of communication for the program. ☐
- Removal from the program may result in the event of:
 - More than two absences in a trimester (summer, fall, or spring)
 - Excessive tardiness, disruption, or lack of participation
 - Not meeting Kings Etiquette
 - Physical altercations or bullying
 - Other reasons deemed appropriate by 100 Black Men of Middle TN's staff, committees, or board☐
- The 100 Black Men of Middle Tennessee reserves the right to determine acceptance and continued participation of students and families in the 100 Kings program to align with the organization's vision, mission, and uphold the standards necessary to maintain program integrity. ☐
